How to register in SAP Business Network?

Have you received an invitation to work with Ingka Group (IKEA) on the SAP Business Network?

How to accept a Trading Relationship Request?

A trading relationship request (TRR) is a link between your supplier account and your customer's account on the SAP Business Network. It allows for the transfer of documents such as purchase orders and invoices between you and your customer.

If you do not have a trading relationship with a customer, you will not be able to invoice that customer or complete any related actions.

How to work with Purchase Orders?

How to create Service Entry Sheets?

For suppliers that are required to create a Service Entry Sheet.

A Service Entry Sheet (SES) is used to document the services you have provided to Ingka Group (IKEA), confirming the completion of work based on the terms of the contract or purchase order.
